#### **DEVOTIONS**



Read: 1 Thessalonians 2:9-13.

The reading this week from 1 Thessalonians 2 fits nicely with Matthew 23. Jesus points out that the hypocritical authority of the scribes and Pharisees is seen by the fact that they do not practice what they preach (Matthew 23:3). Paul and his missionary partners (Silvanus and Timothy) do practice what they preach. Paul writes that the people see it for themselves. What do they see? Missionaries who "deal with each one like a father with his children" (1 Thessalonians 2:11). Reaching others with the gospel is about intimate care for the lives of people, not the status or financial gain of the leaders. It speaks to the good news itself that is

people, not the status or financial gain of the leaders. It speaks to the good news itself that is about authentic lives humbly pointing to God's grace and mercy. Paul describes their message as the word of God, the very word that is active in the lives of believers to "lead a life worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory" (v. 12).

Discuss: How can you tell if a Christian leader practices what they preach?

*Pray:* Almighty God, you call us to lives of service; give us faith and compassion to care for others with the word of God, the message of your Son, our Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.

# **SERVICE**

## **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**



Go on a night walk outside or inside your house with all the lights turned off using a flashlight to guide you. Afterward, think or talk about what it means to be dependent on light to see your way clearly and to guide your path safely. Reflect on how God leads and guides us every day. Read Psalm 43:3-4 as a prayer: "O send out your light and your truth; let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy hill and to your dwelling. Then I will go to the altar of God, to God my exceeding joy; and I will praise you with the harp, O God, my God." Amen.
