Worship

<p>Acolyte: Individuals or families serving in worship to ensure important details are covered, such as tending candles, assisting with communion, and more.</p>	<p>Virtual Worship Host: Do you enjoy socializing on Facebook or YouTube? We are looking for virtual hosts for our live stream broadcasts. Training provided!</p>
<p>Assisting Minister: An Assisting Minister works directly with pastor to help the community worship through reading of prayers, assisting at communion, and inviting participation.</p>	<p>Music & Choirs: Has God gifted you with a love of music? Do you like to sing or play an instrument? Join praise band, or bell choirs and serve worship through song with minimal rehearsal. Offer your instrumental musical gift during worship.</p>
<p>Communion Assistants: serve worship through Holy Communion distribution.</p>	<p>Eucharistic Minister: Deliver Holy Communion to those unable to attend worship. Training will be provided.</p>
<p>Greeter: If you are friendly and enjoy helping others, consider being a greeter. Be the first to welcome others to worship and help guests find the restrooms or sanctuary.</p>	<p>Technology Minister: Enjoy working with computers? Serve worship and run the power point during services, help with issues related to audio/visual during the worship service. Training provided.</p>
<p>Ushers: Hand out bulletins, provide direction for seating as needed, serve worship through hospitality and receiving the offering and bringing the communion elements to the altar.</p>	<p>Altar Guild: Serve worship by preparing and cleaning up for Holy Communion, care for the altar, paraments and cloths.</p>
<p>Lay Reader: Are you a good reader? Do you enjoy telling a good story? Consider reading for worship and help us tell the best story of all time.</p>	<p>Baking Communion Bread: Serve worship by preparing communion bread on a rotating schedule. Recipe and instructions provided. This is great family fun!</p>

Sunday School Teacher/Assistant: Team-teach or help with Sunday School classes.	Substitute Teacher: Occasionally fill in for a Sunday school teacher.
Confirmation Mentor: Be a one-on-one mentor for a 7 th or 8 th grader, walking with them on this part of their faith journey.	Family Ministry: Help the Family Ministry Team help our families to experience faith formation in the home.
Sunday School Music: Lead or accompany music at the opening of Sunday School each week. Helping with Christmas or other seasonal music program rehearsals, props or costumes.	Cross+Gen Ministry: Help plan our cross+generational ministry times. Work with a team to bring the generations together.
Adult Faith Formation: Work with Pastor Paul and team to create programming and share ideas.	Planning Team: Work with the team to create fun learning experiences for our children.

Café Host/Hostess: One or two to make coffee prior to the 9:00am coffee hour, set up, clean up.	Fellowship Team: Do you enjoy planning fun activities? Join the team today!
Senior Luncheon (50+): Seniors meet once a month throughout the year, at a variety of locations, for lunch and fellowship.	Men's Breakfast Group Team: Join the team! Help plan activities and prepare breakfast for monthly gatherings.
Women's Breakfast Group: Join the team! Help plan activities, host breakfast out monthly.

Team Member: Work with a team to develop and execute a plan for comprehensive adult faith formation.	Class Facilitator: Facilitate adult faith formation class using published resources and videos.

Hunger Ministries: Mobile Food Pantry volunteer, help with stocking the little food pantry and ELCA Hunger.	God's Work Our Hands: Help plan and support this annual day of service event held each September.

Provide Meals: Prepare meals and deliver to families during illness or after surgery. As needed.	Prayer Chain: Provides an opportunity through a phone or e-Mail tree to request or offer specific prayers for individuals.
Stephen Ministry: Lay ministers trained and organized to help provide Christian caregiving to members of our congregation and community.	Prayer Shawl Ministry: Pray, knit, crochet and donate blessed shawls to persons needing comfort and support. Meet first and third Thursdays each month year round.

Youth Sponsors: Adults who work with the youth ministry coordinator to provide support for youth group events.	Provide Food: Provide food for youth activities
Easter Breakfast: Assist in coordination of Easter Breakfast.	Provide Transportation: Provide transportation for youth activities.
Parade Hospitality: Work with youth and others to provide hospitality for the Halloween parade.	Youth Ministry Team: Join the team and help us plan and deliver great experiences for our youth grades 6-12.
